### **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

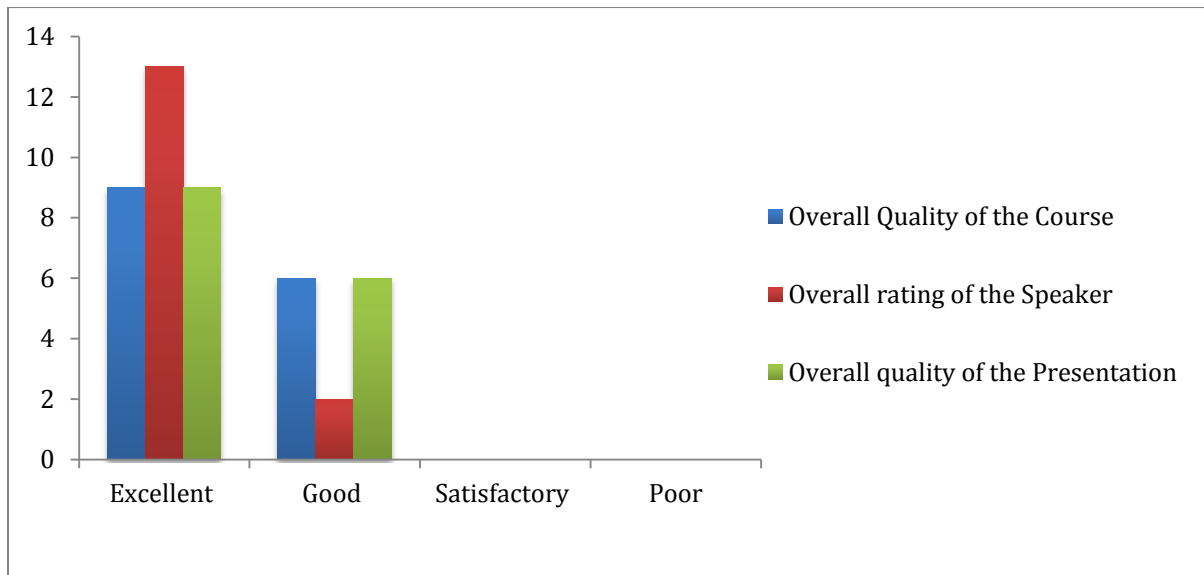
The workshop concluded on a happy note and there were specific comments from the participants. Some of the encouraging comments we received are as follows:
