### **Applicability on NBFCs**

- These Directions apply on all NBFCs (except NBFC-CICs) which fall under following three layers as per the SBR framework ('Specified NBFCs'):
  - Top Layer
  - Upper Layer
  - Middle Layer
- Base Layer NBFCs shall continue to follow the 2017 <u>Master</u> <u>Direction - Information Technology Framework for the NBFC</u>
- In terms of their IT governance framework, Specified NBFCs need to take a number of actions. A summarised list of the significant action items is provided in the adjoining table.

#### **Immediate Action Items**

- Review and re-draft policies w.r.t. information technology, systems, security, IS Audit, BCP and DRM
- Constitute new committee -
  - Information Securities Committee (ISC)
- Reconstitute and update committee ToR for
  - o IT Strategy Committee (ITSC), IT Steering Committee
- Update ToR for RMC and ACB
- Designate officer(s), allocate staff and resources and set up reporting lines for -
  - Head of IT Function, CISO
- Adopt/ revise framework for various assessments, reviews and testing (e.g. IT risk assessment, capacity assessment, DR drills, IT vendor assessment, etc.)
- Convene Board, ACB and RMC meetings to review and adopt changes
