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Why this Webinar?

The recent 27th March amendments of SEBI introduces a separate chapter VA for corporate governance norms applicable to High Value Debt Listed Entities, now redefined with a threshold of Rs 1000 crores. The separate framework has all the nitty gritty of corporate governance norms, viz., board and committee composition, appointment of independent directors and maximum no. of directorships, secretarial audit requirements, etc. Related party transactions by these issuers will now have to get sanction of debentureholders, through debenture trustees, before going to shareholders' approval.

The new regime is **already effective**.

Some of the nagging questions:

- What is the new approval regime for material RPTs of HVDLEs? What transactions, whose approval, how do we seek it?
- Role of debenture trustees
- Shareholders' approval: is it majority or minority rule?
- For transactions already approved by audit committee and may be shareholders, do we now go to debentureholders? What about new debt issues?
- Coverage of subsidiaries' RPTs and compliances with respect to subsidiaries
- Alignment of board and committee composition as per revised Corporate Governance norms etc
